Who needs MARK Falcon?

MARK Falcon has been designed especially for amateur users and self-rescue purposes, e.g. as an escape route in case of a fire (hotels, schools, offices, private buildings etc.).

Use

MARK Falcon is self-braking, i.e. you do not have to hold on to the rope while descending. Persons who have to escape from a danger zone (e.g. because of a fire, when the escape way/the stairs are blocked) quickly have a reliable and easy-to-use tool at hand.

Braking system - maximum safety

MARK Falcon comes with a redundant braking system. The brake drums are made of steel. This ensures your safety while you are descending.

Inspection

MARK Falcon has to be inspected after 2,000m or after being subjected to major loads (e.g. a rescue deployment) by MARK Save A Life or by a comptetent person.
